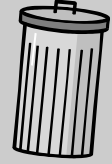

This holiday tradition may not be one of which songs are written, but it's something every good TSS customer needs to know. Thompson's Sanitary Service observes three holidays a year; Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's.

Thanksgiving Week

Thanksgiving is Thursday, November 23, 2006. Thursday's (Thanksgiving) route will be picked up on Wednesday, November 22 which is the **day before** Thanksgiving. All other pick-up days remain the same.

Christmas Week

Monday, Christmas, Dec. 25th, route will be picked up on Tuesday, the 26th which is the day after Christmas. **Tuesday, the 26th**, route will be picked up Wednesday, and **Wednesday, the 27th**, route will be picked up Thursday. All other pick-up days remain the same.

New Year's Week

Monday, New Year's, January 1, 2007 route will be picked up on Tuesday, the 2nd which is the day after New Year's. **Tuesday, the 2nd**, route will be picked up on Wednesday, and **Wednesday, the 3rd**, route will be picked up on Thursday. All other pick-up days remain the same.

River Clean-Up a Success!

If you drove the Yaquina Bay Road Saturday morning, September 16th, 2006, you most likely noticed the caution signs and people in orange vests picking up litter along the Yaquina River. Over fifty volunteers came out in force to help with the Adopt-a River Yaquina River Cleanup.

Thompson's Sanitary Service and Georgia Pacific, Toledo partnered with SOLV for this bi-annual cleanup event.

It was held in conjunction with the Great Oregon Beach Cleanup in efforts to maximize awareness of both the beaches and rivers here in Lincoln County. Thompson's Sanitary Service and Georgia Pacific, Toledo both adopted a stretch of the Yaquina River through the SOLV Adopt-a-River program to cover from the mouth of the river to Toledo. Part of their adoption requires they hold

cleanup events twice a year for the next two years.

Volunteers gathered trash along the banks of the river and the waterway itself for a total of over 3,000 pounds of debris including 12 foam filled tires, 13 tires off the rim, and 1 tire on the rim. After

the event, local supporters, the Krabbe family, opened their home along the Yaquina River for a complimentary barbecue lunch for all that volunteered.
