Mixed Compostables: If it grows, it goes!



ALL FOOD

fruits, vegetables, meat, poultry, seafood, bones, grains, beans, pasta, bread, cheese, and eggshells

FOOD-SOILED PAPER

napkins, paper towels, paper plates, tea bags, coffee grounds/filters, wooden crates, sawdust

PLANTS

floral trimmings, tree trimmings, grass, brush, weeds

Mixed Recycling



PAPER / CARDBOARD

Flattened Cardboard, Junk mail, magazines, flyers, office paper, envelopes, gift wrap & cards (no foil), post-it notes, paper bags, newspaper, paperboard, phone books/paperback books, shredded paper (loose in a paper bag or cereal box).

METAL

RINSE tin & aluminum cans. aluminum foil, pie pans, & metal lids empty aerosol cans (do not puncture or remove nozzle),, other scrap metal (30lb. max, no longer than 30 in).

PLASTIC

RINSE FIRST. Plastic bottles (over 6 oz), jugs, tubs (yogurt, margarine), jars (peanut butter). Numbers #1-7.

GLASS

Glass can be recycled at the following depot locations:

- Agate Beach Recycling Center
- South Beach @ Roque Brewerv

PAINT

Bring your paint/ stain in original containers for free recycling to the Agate Beach Transfer Station.

BATTERIES


Household batteries can be recycled at the following locations:

Service Size/Frequency	What it includes:
24 gallon cart weekly	Includes weekly curbside collection of the following: 24 gallon landfill, 65 gallon co-mingled & 96 gallon mixed compostables recycling
24 gallon cart weekly (without compostables)	Includes weekly curbside collection of the following: 24 gallon landfill and 65 gallon co-mingled recycling.
35 gallon cart weekly	Includes weekly curbside collection of the following: 35 gallon landfill, 65 gallon co-mingled, & 96 gallon mixed compostables recycling
35 gallon monthly	Includes monthly curbside collection of the following: 35 gallon landfill and 65 gallon co-mingled recycling. Weekly curbside collection of 96 gallon mixed compostables recycling.
65 gallon weekly	Includes weekly curbside collection of the following: 65 gallon landfill, 65 gallon co-mingled, & 96 gallon mixed compostables recycling.
65 gallon monthly	Includes monthly curbside collection of the following: 65 gallon landfill and 65 gallon co-mingled recycling. Weekly curbside collection of 96 gallon mixed compostables recycling.

Disposal Tips

Place all carts out before 6:00 am on your service day

Mixed Compostables

- Collect food waste in a container with a tight-fitting lid in a convenient place in your kitchen. Line your kitchen container with newspaper or a BPI-approved compostables bag.
- Put out compostables cart every week.
- 'Layer' yard debris under and on top of food waste to keep the cart cleaner and odor free.

Co-mingled Recycling

- · Rinse all containers before placing in cart.
- Contain loose recyclables in paper bags or boxes so they don't fly out when cart is being emptied.

Motor Oil

Place motor oil in a plastic jug with a tight fitting screw-on lid beside the cart (2 gallon limit for each service day)

Cash for Clunkers/Refrigerators
